### England - Derbyshire - £4.00 per tree

#### Project Goals (GB-DB2):

This project involves planting at a children's outdoor camp, which has been designed to introduce more tree cover to the site. In particular, we are planting conifer trees alongside the perimeters of the site to offer year-round privacy for children on site.

### England - Derbyshire - £5.30 per tree

#### Project Goals (GB-DB1):

This project involves planting at a children's outdoor recreational centre, contributing to their rewilding and conservation programme, run as part of their curriculum. This project will also form part of a lapwing habitat creation on site along the field boundaries.

## UK Planting Sites Overview

### England - West Sussex - £5.50 per tree

#### Project Goals (GB-WS5):

This project will plant a diverse mix of 14 tree and shrub species to support an ongoing beaver reintroduction initiative. The planting will stabilise riverbanks, improve water retention, and help manage both drought and flood risk.



### Scotland - East Lothian - £6.00 per tree

#### Project Goals (GB-EL1):

This project will establish wide shelterbelts across the exposed farmland, creating protection from harsh coastal winds while strengthening habitat diversity. Over time, these trees will form vital corridors across the site, supporting both the wider rural ecosystem.

## **England - Birmingham - £6.70 per tree**

## Project Goals (GB-WM1):

This project involves the restoration of fragmented woodland and hedgerow. The species of the site have been specifically selected to tolerate the wet conditions of the site, which will help manage the groundwater in the future.

## **Northern Ireland - Belfast - £7.65 per tree**

## Project Goals (GB-DW1):

This project will involve the creation of high density microforest that will provide a space for wildlife to thrive through a simulated microclimate. Species have been chosen to provide habitats for local birds such as woodpeckers, jay birds, pheasants and kites.

### England - Kent - £9.90 per tree

#### Project Goals (GB-KT6):

We are working with a local farmer to turn degraded agricultural land into woodland. This site provides wildlife corridors to nearby Blean Woods, home to the rare Heath Fritillary butterfly and Lesser Spotted Woodpeckers.
